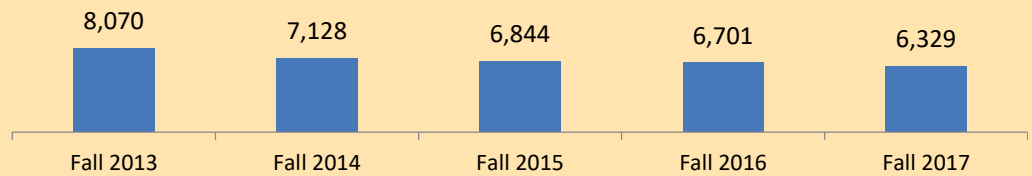

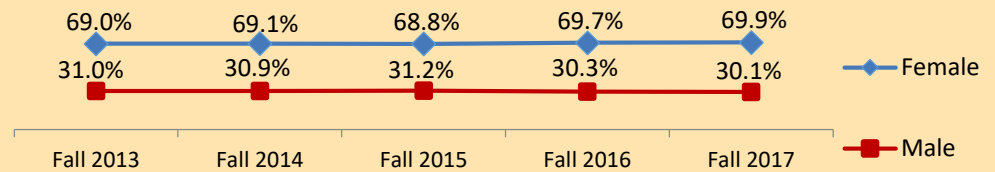

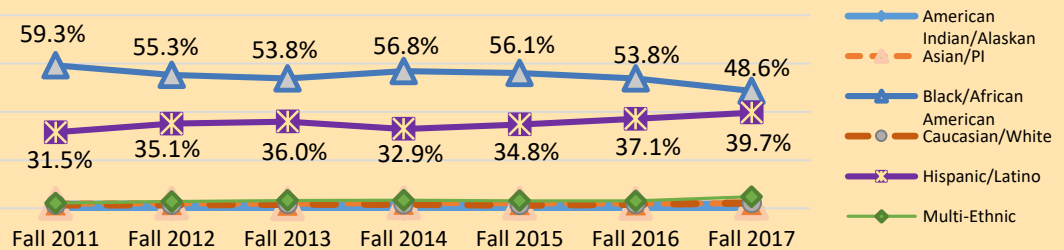
#### Fall Credit Headcount
